We grieve the lack of implementation of the 339 recommendations by the Australian Government and as this injustice continues, so does the deep and ongoing grief experienced by First Nations families and communities.</p> <p>As followers of Jesus, we are called not to turn away, but to draw near - in lament, in prayer, and in action.
